Scope of Work:

Development of Lead Health and Safety Plan

The written site-specific Lead Health Protection Program (LHPP) will be prepared. by a CIH, the plan covers all workers on the project (Contractor, Subcontractor and Conn DOT Representatives). The LHPP will include procedures for medical surveillance of the contractors, subcontractors and the state project-related representatives, hazard communication procedures, employee training, protective equipment, and all other procedures that may be necessary to comply with 29 CFR Part 1926.62 pertaining to lead exposure in construction.

Typical work tasks that pose a lead exposure risk consist of, but are not limited to, welding, burning paint, flame cutting, abrasive blast cleaning, grinding, chipping, needle gun cleaning, lead burning and other.

Specialty Industrial Hygiene Services

EnviroMed will provide an Industrial Hygienist to supervise the lead abatement activities. The Industrial Hygienist will conduct exposure assessment during lead exposure risk activities. The assessment will include conduct Lead air samples, lead wipe samples and ambient air sampling.

Lead Health Protection Program Monthly Compliance Report

EnviroMed will provide a monthly Lead Health Protection Compliance Report. The compliance report will describe the Description of Operations, Engineering and Work Practice Controls, Workers Training, Respiratory Protection Program, Medical Surveillance, Personal Air Monitoring Data, Ambient Air Quality monitoring results, Surface Dust Samples, Water Samples, Soil Samples, Hazard Communication and Site Inspection. The Environmental Health and Safety Compliance Reports are prepared and signed off by a Certified Industrial (CIH).
